

Movie author needs investors to fulfill a dream

A SHOP owner is heading for the Cannes Film Festival – but needs £12,000 to help her on her way.

Paula Wynne of Hermitage Road, Cold Ash, works in the family-run Chapel Row Store and Post Office and has been writing screenplays in her spare time.

The 42-year-old set up World Friend Films last year with a view to writing and producing her own films.

Since then, the mother-of-one has assembled a team of 10 cast and crew and is ready to put a script into action with the help of producer Chantelle De Carvalho. Now all she needs is an investor.
