

# Former postmistress's film takes flight

BRIMPTON airfield will be transformed into a film set when the former postmistress of Chapel Row begins production of her film.

Paula Wynne, 42, has sold up the post office at Chapel Row and is taking off for greater things.

She will spend time producing her short film *Dare To Fly*, which will be shot at Brimpton Airfield Aldermaston.

*Dare To Fly* tells the tale of two teenage brothers who are distant and uncommunicative until they are united by their mutual dream of flying.

Mrs Wynne said: "I'm very excited, I can't wait to get into production."

Mrs Wynne, a full time public relations officer, wrote the film herself and will produce it during her spare time with two filmmakers, David Marsh and John Chapman.
